How to get the busID key card

- 1 Fill in this application form.
- 2 Include a recent passport sized photograph (30mm x 40mm) of yourself.
- 3 Include proof of your date of birth. Birth certificate, passport or driving licence are accepted.
- 4 Post your completed **application form** together with **proof of age** and **passport sized photo** to:

or take into **1 Stop Travel** at 26 North Street, BRIGHTON, BN1 1EB. No need to bring a photo if you're popping in as our friendly staff can take one for you.

Terms and conditions

- busID key cards are free and valid for 3 periods - up to the end of the month after your 10th and 15th birthdays and up to 31 August after your 18th birthday.
- During busier periods your card will be posted to you as soon as we are able to.
- Lost, stolen or damaged cards can be replaced for a £5 administrative charge.
- We cannot be responsible for items lost if sending application forms by post.
- busID citySAVER tickets are not valid on night services.
- busID networkSAVER tickets are valid on night services.
- All tickets purchased for a busID key card must be completely used before the card expires or they will cease to be valid.
- Additional charges will be applied if a busID key card is used beyond its expiry date.
- We may ask for further proof of age when we issue the card or at any time before the card expires.
- We reserve the right to refuse or cancel membership of the scheme.

How to use your busID key card on the bus if you have pre-loaded tickets on it

- 1 Touch your busID key card on the reader by the driver
- 2 Wait for the beep and a green light*
- 3 Find a seat

You can check what SAVER tickets you still have left on your busID key card by logging into your online account at smartbuses.co.uk

*If a red light displays when you touch your card on the reader, there may be a problem - the driver will be able to help you.

busID cash fares - pay the driver

1 ride 50p For any one-way journey, any time, any day when travelling with an adult. Up to 3 busID holders can travel per adult.

1 ride £1 For any one-way journey at weekends, specified school holidays and after 6pm on schooldays when travelling alone.

1 day £2.50 One day citySAVER for travel all over the city but not valid on night buses. See map below for citySAVER area.

1 day £4 One day networkSAVER for travel on all our buses.

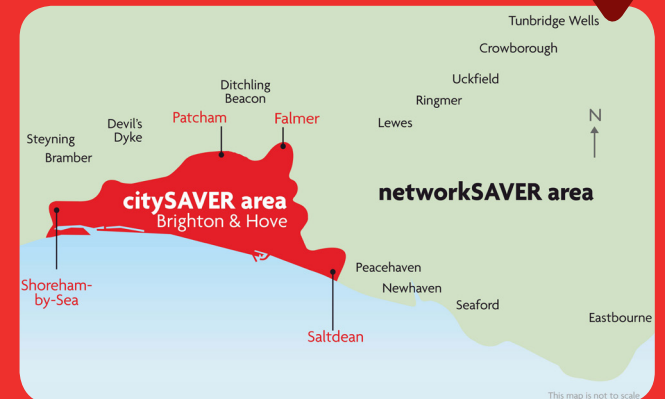
