

This Sunday, 3rd September, sees the return of the Swindon Half Marathon on a revised route. This will cause huge disruption to our entire town network for the hours it is action. At this time we are unable to commit to exact timings of road re-openings as this is unknown.

On the information we have been given by the organisers, we have planned the following diversions and/ or break in service for the following services:

- **Service 1/1A -**
 - Will be unable to run from 10:00am to GWH until Coate Water roundabout has reopened.
 - 1/1A's to West Swindon will continue to run throughout closures on the following diversion. Outbound via Westcott Place and Wootton Bassett Road and inbound via Penzance Drive and then right in to Rodbourne Road (marshalled turn). After this service will go via Sheppard Street and Station Road (Regent Circus closed).

- **Service R1 -**
 - Will operate throughout the closures on the following diversion. Outbound via Westcott Place and Wootton Bassett Road and inbound via Penzance Drive and then right in to Rodbourne Road (marshalled turn).

- **Service 2 -** will be unable to run from 10:00am until Greenbridge Road reopens at which time it will resume full route

- **Service 5 -**
 - Southern end during the Queen's Drive closure we will operate Manchester Road, County Road, Ocotal Way, Drakes Way, Marlowe Avenue. Back to normal route once Frobisher Drive reopens.
 - Northern end will operate via Westcott Place, Wootton Bassett Road, Great Western Way to Bruce Street and onwards. Inbound from the north via Great Western Way, Paddington Drive, Penzance Drive, Rodbourne Road. After this service will go via Sheppard Street and Station Road (Regent Circus closed).

- **Service 11 -**
 - Northern end will operate throughout closure via a marshalled crossing at Cockleberry Roundabout.
 - Southern end is likely to be affected from road closure time to the full length of the operating day. To be monitored throughout the race.

- **Service 13/14 -**
 - will be unable to run from 10:00am until Edison roundabout reopens at which time it will resume full route.

- **Service 17 -**
 - Northbound will operate throughout the closure via Whitehouse Road, Ferndale Road, Gorse Hill in both directions.
 - Southbound the 17's will run to Park South once Whitbourne Avenue has reopened. To return to town 17's will go via Drove Road and Fleming Way (Regent Circus closed)
