The **Young Persons' TravelPass** gives unlimited travel on all Thamesdown and Stagecoach buses within the Swindon urban area (Inner & Outer zones).

Boundary points: Blunsdon; South Marston Park; Stratton Park Sainsburys; Common Head; Thorney Park; Elcombe Turn; Spittleborough M4; Washpool Turn.

The **Young Persons' TravelPass PLUS** gives unlimited travel on all Thamesdown and Stagecoach buses within the Swindon urban area **AND** to and from Purton, Royal Wootton Bassett, Cricklade, Highworth, South Marston, Wanborough, Foxhill, Chiseldon and Draycot Foliat.

Boundary points: Royal Wootton Bassett Whitehill Lane; Cricklade; Latton; Haresfield Roundabout; South Marston Acorn Bridge; Foxhill Shepherd's Rest; Whitefields Hill; Draycot Foliat; Elcombe Turn.

How does it work?



The **Young Persons' TravelPass** is loaded onto a Young Persons' TravelCard.

When you get on a Thamesdown or Stagecoach bus, simply place the card on the ticket machine.

Wait for the 'beep' and then take your card and enjoy the journey!

If there is no 'beep', the driver will check your card is valid and return it to you.

Where can I get hold of a TravelPass?



Please complete the **Application Form** overleaf and bring it with you to the Thamesdown Travel Shop in Fleming Way. You'll also need a passport-size photo and proof of age (e.g. a CitizenCard, passport, birth certificate or driving licence).

What options of Young Persons' TravelPass are available?

1 week Young Persons' TravelPass

Once you have made your choice, the TravelCard will only load the same type of pass on to your card.

If you wish to change to a different pass or duration you will need to visit our Fleming Way Travel Shop to re-programme your card.

How do I top it up?

Cards can be topped up at our Travel Shop or on a Thamesdown bus - exact money is required on bus as change is not given by drivers!

If your 4 week card expires and you just need an extra 1 week's travel you can buy a 'paper' ticket on the bus. Just show your card to the driver and ask for a **1 week paper ticket**. Exact money is required on bus, as no change is given by drivers!

When you show your 1 week 'paper' ticket to the driver you also need to show your orange TravelCard at the same time.

Terms & Conditions

Full terms and conditions of issue and use of a Young Persons' TravelCard are available on our website - www.thamesdownbus.com

You can load a second pass onto your card before your current one expires. The second pass will

only become active when you place the card on the ticket machine's bullseye after the first card has expired. It will not automatically start on the day after the expiry of the first one.

If your card becomes lost, stolen or damaged, it can be 'hotlisted' to prevent it being used again.

A replacement card can be issued at our Fleming Way Travel Shop (Mondays to Saturdays) for a fee of £5.
